

Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: *ck* words

Think of *ck* as a pair of letters that work together to create the /k/ sound. When you see *ck* at the end of a word, after a short vowel sound, it signals that the strong /k/ sound is coming.

For example:

In the word *back*, the *ck* follows a short /a/ sound to produce a /k/ sound at the end of the word.

In the word *pick*, the *ck* follows a short /i/ sound to produce a /k/ sound at the end of the word.

Use the spelling activities to work through the words in this list. Can you spot the short vowel sound in each one?
