Word list: *old* and *oll* words

In this list, the long /o/ sound is spelled with the letter *o* in words ending with *-old* or *-oll*. These common words often describe actions, objects, or characteristics.

For example, *cold* describes a low temperature, while *gold* refers to a precious metal. Words like *fold*, *scroll*, and *troll* function as both nouns and verbs.

These familiar words are excellent practice for building everyday vocabulary.
