

Handwriting sheet: Precursive Arrow worksheet

Word list: Long /oo/ spelled ew

The ew spelling for the long /oo/ sound usually appears at the end of words, as in *crew* and *jewel*. It is often found in verbs, such as *flew*, *threw*, and *chew*.

Though the pronunciation of ew words is generally consistent, there are some words, like *sew*, the letter combination does not make the long /oo/ sound. Listening to these words carefully while learning to spell them will help reinforce this pattern. Click on the *speaker icon* to hear each word said aloud.
