Word list: oi and oy words

The letter combinations *oi* and *oy* are used to represent the same sound in different words. For example, *oil* and *coin* have the *oi* pattern, while *boy* and *joy* use *oy*.

When spelling words with *oi* or *oy*, make sure you use the correct combination:

If the /oi/ sound falls in the middle of a word, use the letters *oi* to spell it.

If the /oi/ sound falls at the end of a word, use the letters *oy* to spell it.

Be aware of exceptions, such as in *oyster*, *coyote*, and the past tense forms of verbs that end in *oy* like *enjoyed* or *deployed*.
