

Spelling list: Words ending in *k/e*

The /k l/ sound at the end of a word can be spelled *k/e* , especially if the word has only two syllables.

ankle	I have a pain in my right ankle .
crackle	The fire started to crackle in the stove.
shackle	The shackle broke, causing the load to fall off the truck.
tackle	The government planned to tackle tax avoidance.
sparkle	Her crystal beads sparkle in the sunlight.
freckle	She had a freckle on her right cheek.
heckle	The students decided to heckle the speaker.
speckle	Each speckle was a different colour.
fickle	A fickle person changes their mind often.
pickle	I would like a cheese and pickle sandwich.
tickle	The feather will tickle my nose.
prickle	My skin starts to prickle in the heat.
crinkle	The corners of his eyes crinkle when he smiles.
sprinkle	I like to sprinkle some chocolate on my coffee.
twinkle	There was a twinkle in her eye.
wrinkle	Grandma says she has a new wrinkle every day.
buckle	My belt buckle has broken.
suckle	Baby mammals suckle as soon as they are born.
chuckle	Olivia's joke made us chuckle .
